Fifty-two people in Tuscaloosa died as a result of the tornado, which destroyed about 12 percent of Tuscaloosa. Two local media organizations, The Tuscaloosa News and WVUA-TV, covered the tornado aftermath and the recovery. The present research interviews five journalists, drawn from each local media organization, to investigate how they

have coped with witnessing or suffering direct loss from the tornado. Three of the five journalists suffered direct loss from the tornado.
